Author Presentation Summaries

Laura is an award-winning author. She writes Picture Books, Graphic Novels for Young Readers, and she is also currently working on a middle-grade novel. Being a former teacher, her presentations are fun, lively, interactive, and educational. She strives to make sure that the students not only enjoy the presentations, but that they also come away with new ideas and skills to apply to their own creativity, reading, and writing, that connect with grade-level curriculum as well. The audience grade-levels stated below are guidelines; the presentations can certainly include other grade levels with students close in age. Laura can also tailor the presentations to specific writing skills the students are working on.

- **Smart Cookies Read, Write, & Imagine**

Audience: **Geared towards PreK-1st**

Length: 45 minutes (including GB Man Quiz Show Game at the end)

Laura will celebrate reading and writing with an enthusiastic, energetic, and educational presentation that includes a little about Laura as a child, teacher, and author; an interactive call & response book-reading with PowerPoint slide show, simple ideas on how to find story ideas, and an audience-participation "*Gingerbread Man Quiz Show*" as well as a preview of the next Gingerbread Man adventure. May include Q & A or sharing "connections" time.

- **Story Ideas Fresh from the Oven**

Audience: **Geared towards grades 2-3**

Length: 50-60 mins (including GB Man game or Reader's Theater)

In this interactive presentation, Laura provides a sneak peek at a writer's journey. She builds on the presentations for younger audiences, but also incorporate tricks to come up with ideas, character motivations and problems, and ideas on how to craft those elements into a story. She encourages audience participation through an interactive reading, a Gingerbread Man game or reader's theater, and an idea-generating exercise for the next Gingerbread Man adventure (which can often turn into a fun classroom creative writing activity afterwards.) Question and answer time will follow.

- **Sweet Success: Tips & Tools for Student Writing**

Audience: **Geared towards 3- 4th grade (If you are interested in including 5th grade, I can send you additional information)**

Length: 60 minutes (including Think Quick Trivia game)

This presentation is geared towards older children, incorporates the same engaging and educational elements as presentations for younger audiences, with a concentration on skills to help young authors grow. Laura will share *5 Tips and Tools for Young Writers* on creating ideas, character motivation and

conflicts, revision and perseverance, as well as contests that accept young author's work. Laura will guide students in the recognition of these writing techniques from one of her GB Man books as a mentor text. A fun "Think Quick Trivia" game will close the presentation. Q & A will follow.

- **Virtual Visit Presentations**

Audience: Any age group

Length: 30-45 minutes, depending on age group

Author Skype visits are fun & educational, and are a wonderful lower-cost alternative if an in-person visit isn't possible. These virtual visits mirror the fun content of Laura's in-person presentations, with an interactive book reading for younger audiences, and interactive examples about how to find story ideas, elements of the writing process, revision, publishing, and ending with Q & A with the students. - **Free 15 minute Skype Q & A Sessions**

Audience: Any age group

Laura also offers 15 minute free Skype sessions during the year. Each school year, she announces 1-2 available dates for these sessions and uses her **Activities Newsletter** as a way to spread the word to teachers & librarians about the dates. - **Classroom Visit Q & A Sessions**

For Grades 2 and up

Length: 30 minutes

If a class or small group of students has several questions for Laura, consider a Classroom Visit Session. Most large group presentations usually only allow for about 5 minutes of questions. A Classroom Visit Session gives a class or small group of students and teachers the chance to interact with Laura and ask questions about the writing process and the publishing process in a more personal setting, with time enough to answer all questions. Brainstorming & writing down questions ahead of time works well.

A Few Other Details about in-person presentations:

- Laura can offer up to 3 presentations/workshops/sessions in one school day.
- When considering a schedule, please refer to presentation lengths, with a 10-15 minute reset time between presentations.
- Maximum number of students at a large group presentation is 250.
- If a full day is booked, lunch will need to be worked into the schedule too. ☺
- If your school is interested in ordering books to be signed, Laura will be happy to sign books before, in-between, or after all the presentations are done, when time allows. Laura can also sign and personalize special Gingerbread Man bookplate stickers for "after-visit" book orders.
